ROB FALSINI

Rob Falsini is a singer songwriter based in London and an established performer at the world-famous street performances venue Covent Garden. In September 2014, 95.7 KJR radio from Seattle uploaded on their Facebook page a live video of Rob singing Chasing Cars by Snow Patrol. The video went viral straight away and registered well over 3,000,000 views and 250,000 shares in the space of 3 months. As a result of that video, Rob got 43,000 followers on his Facebook page in 6 months and was approached by producer Stephane DeReine. They released an album called Streets Are Never Fake. From 2005 till 2008 he performed as lead singer and co-lyricist for the multi million dollar show Le Reve at Wynn Las Vegas directed by Franco Dragone and music by Benoit Jutras.

She's currently running a choir at **Solace Women's Aid**, a charity providing lifesaving support to women and children survivors of domestic and sexual violence.
